### Environmental Induction and Construction Management Plan Compliance

- All activities should keep in mind the environmental susceptibility of the area, and an effort should be made to minimise potential impacts. Animals and plants should not be unnecessarily harmed, and habitats should be kept intact as far as possible. No trimming or clearing of endangered plants (such as milkwoods) shall be done without the ECO's express permission.
- No natural areas may be disturbed in any way prior to Search and Rescue and sign-off by botanist (Sean Privett)
- Do not feed any wild animals.
- All site personal must use the site ablutions. The use of fynbos as a toilet is strictly prohibited.
- Some areas are strictly no-go areas, and these have been surrounded by temporary fencing.
- Any littering is strictly prohibited. Place any litter in bins provided (taking care to replace the lid, ensuring no litter is blown away by the wind), or ensure that any litter you generate is removed from the site.
- Smoking is prohibited in areas where there is a fire hazard (areas where vegetation or other material is liable to spread an initial flame, and fuel storage areas).
- Drip trays should be used under any vehicles or machinery to prevent oil leaks from contaminating soil and ground water.

- The storage of any harmful chemicals on site should be kept to a minimum, and any such chemicals should be kept in a safe place, and for as short amount of time as possible.
- Fires, fire making and collecting of fire wood is not allowed.
- Any mixing of cement or concrete must be done on an impermeable surface, to prevent contamination of soil and groundwater.
- If any archaeological discoveries or human remains/grave sites are discovered, these should be reported immediately, and work in the surrounding area should be halted.
- Any activities should endeavour to minimise any soil erosion, and the placement of erosion preventative measures (storm water drains etc) should be done in the necessary areas.

The abovementioned items have been explained by the ECO to the undersigned representative who will adhere to these items at all times. In the event of non-compliance, a monetary fine may be imposed, or any remedial measures that must be taken will be charged to the contractor responsible, or both.
